A. Be sure you have put to memory Luke 2:14:

*Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace  
among those with whom he is pleased!* <sup>ESV</sup>

B. Answer the following questions about **Matthew 18:23-35**.

1. Why did Jesus tell this parable, according to verses 21-22?
2. What does Jesus compare this parable to (v. 23)? What did the King set out to do and why?
3. What needed to be done with the servant that owed ten thousand talents in order to pay back what he owed (v. 25)? What did the servant do after the order was given (v. 26)? What did the King do and what reason is given for this (v. 27)?
4. What did this servant do after leaving the King with his great debt forgiven according to verses 28 to 31? What did the King do when he found this out (vs. 32-35)?

C. Answer the following questions about **1 John 4:8-12**.

1. What does verse 8 say that God is? What does it say about those who do not love?
2. What does verse 9 say about how to see and know what God's love is? What was the result of His sacrificial action?
3. According to verse 10, what did God accomplish in this sacrificial action and what did he receive from us?
4. What is an obvious application for us (vs. 11-12)? How does this relate to Jesus' parable about the unforgiving servant?

E. Answer the following questions about **Matthew 9:10-13**.

1. What is Jesus doing according to verse 10 and who was there?
2. Why did this come under the criticism of the Pharisees (v. 11)? Why do you think they didn't ask Jesus their question?
3. What did Jesus say when he heard the Pharisees, according to verses 12-13? What then were the Pharisees doing well? What more important action were they missing? Who then would you say that Jesus has for us to love like he loves?

F. Application.

1. With Jesus as your example, how would you assess your love for all people?
2. Are there those that you treat with indifference?
3. Has the Lord convicted you about how you begin to love someone more like Him? Who is it and what are you to do?
