2. What is God worthy of? What are these things? Who ought to give this to God? What two reasons are given for why God is worthy of these things?

### C. Answer the following questions about **Genesis 1:3**.

1. What does this verse record coming into existence? What do you think this is referring to?
2. How does it say that this came into existence? How is this possible?

### D. Answer the following questions about **Genesis 1:11**.

1. What does this verse record coming into existence?
2. How does it say that this happened (first words)? What was the result according to the last few words of this verse?

### E. Answer the following questions about **Genesis 1:1**.

1. What happened and when, according to this first verse of the Bible?
2. Since this happened in the beginning, what was there before it occurred? What then does this say that God created everything from?

### F. Answer the following questions about **Genesis 1:31**.

1. What did God look at according to this verse? What did he see when he looked at it all?
2. Do you think that this was true because God said so or because this is what it was by nature?

### G. Answer the following questions about **Colossians 1:16**.

1. Who is this passage in reference to? What does it say happened by him? What is included in this and what is specifically listed? Why do you think these things are listed?
2. Why did all this happen according to the end of the verse? What are the ramifications of this truth?

### H. **Application**.

1. Bringing this all down to where we live, how and why does creation exist?
2. Making it personal, how and why do you exist? What difference ought this make in your life?
