2. When will this change?

D. Answer the following questions about **1 John 4:16**.

1. What is God according to this verse? What do you think this means?
2. What does this truth mean for how God sees you?

E. Answer the following questions about **1 Peter 5:10**.

1. What does this verse say that God is and how much? What did he do for you in Christ?
2. What will he do after you have suffered awhile and why?

F. Answer the following questions about **Luke 1:50**.

1. What does this verse say that is for those who fear God?
2. What does this attribute of God mean for those who receive it?

G. Answer the following questions about **1 Peter 1:14-16**.

1. What quality of God is presented as an example that we should follow?
2. What does this quality refer to?

H. Answer the following questions about **2 Chronicles 19:7**.

1. What should people “let” be upon them, so that they are careful what they do? What reason is given for doing this?
2. What does this quality of God ultimately mean for all people?

1. How does knowing that God is good, and there by love, gracious and merciful, affect how you relate to Him?
2. What strikes you most about God’s holiness? What about his righteousness?
