Working Together to SAVE GORDON!

Gordon is a pretty amazing guy! He came to us a little over 6 months ago. He is 78 and is struggling with onset dementia and other health issues. He is very polite, gracious and loves to tell stories from his colorful past. We found out he was houseless and had nowhere to go or stay. He had been out in Bly where he has some property. We later found out that someone had convinced him to sign over the property and dropped him off downtown.

In building a rapport which grew to a friendship, we foound out that Gordon didn't have identification. We began the process of getting his Social Security Card and obtained an identification card for him from DMV. We discovered that during the night, he would get up half asleep and go outside and wander on the property. We felt that we had to protect him and by putting buzzers/alarms on the exterior doors so we could be easily notified if he "escaped" outside.

He was here for about three months when he left with a guest. We were genuinely concerned, but we had no idea even what direction he went....About 1 month later we got a call from Modoc County, CA Modoc Medical Services who were calling on behalf of Gordon.

So Gordon returned to us after a week stay in Modoc County. We assigned our case manager, Billy, to him and slowly began to unravel all the challenges of finding him a home. An apartment finally opened up in a local assisted care facility and he was accepted as a resident. A win! We were excited! Billy was able to take Gordon shopping for basic needs and our Mission Thrift Ministries was able to provide him with furniture!

Today Gordon is safe and well. He is getting the support he needs on a daily basis. He is no longer living on the streets all alone. This is one of the many programs you support when you give to the Klamath Falls Gospel Mission. Some guests are easier to love than others, and I am here to say that Gordon is one special guy!
