## Review & Study: THE LAW

### B. Answer the following questions about **Matthew 5:17-20**.

1. Where is Jesus when he speaks these words and who is his audience? What has he taught so far in his sermon?
2. What does Jesus say that he did not come to do (v. 17)? What does he say he actually did? What do the terms translated “Law” and “Prophets,” refer to? How has Jesus fulfilled them?
3. What does verse 18 say about the Law? What do you think makes Jesus so sure about this? What does this say for the reliability of the Bible in its original form?
4. What will result from someone who relaxes his or her stand on the Law (v. 19)? What will result for those who do and teach the Law?
5. How did Jesus’ original audience view the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees? What was actually true about them? How can anyone attain a position of pure righteousness, be acceptable to God, and enter the Kingdom of heaven?

### C. Answer the following questions about **1 Peter 1:17-19**.

1. According to verse 17, how are we, as followers of Jesus, to conduct ourselves while we are alive on earth? Why is this?
2. What does verse 18 say that we need to know?
3. What does verse 19 say that Jesus was like when he redeemed us with his blood? Could any one else have saved us? Why?

### D. Answer the following questions about **John 14:15**.

1. What will you do if you love Jesus? Why is this so?
2. What are the commandments that Jesus is referring to?

### E. Answer the following questions about **1 John 3:6**.

1. What does this say about those who abide in Jesus?
2. What are the ramifications of the truth in this verse?
